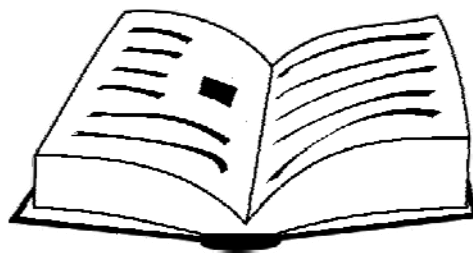


Giving the Library Used Books?

The Library is pleased to accept most books – hardcover and paperback – in good condition and LESS THAN 10 YEARS OLD. Books will be either added to the collection – or – given to the Library FRIENDS for their used book sale which also benefits the Library.

We Especially Need:

- Books published in the last 5 years and recent bestsellers
- Clean copies of “classic” titles
- “Paperback” romances, mysteries, urban fiction, and westerns in good condition

We Cannot Use:

- Books in poor condition (yellowed pages, broken bindings, musty smelling)
- Textbooks
- Dated information
- Magazines
- Encyclopedias
- Video or audio tapes
- Reader’s Digest Condensed Books
- Time-Life Sets
- Puzzles
- Record Albums

We’d Love to Have:

- Roseville area telephone books 1900-1960
- Roseville city directories 1900-1960
- Printed materials about Roseville: companies, maps, family histories, churches, etc.
- Roseville area school yearbooks (any year)
- Photos of Roseville and Roseville residents before 1980

Tax Receipts:

- We give receipts for the number of items, but cannot assess the value
