
Donating Gently Used Materials

The Library is pleased to accept most materials that are <u>LESS THAN 10 YEARS OLD</u> and in good condition. Materials in good condition are free of musty smells, pet hair, yellowing of pages, and broken bindings. Donated materials will be either added to the collection or given to the Friends of the Library for their used book sale.

We would LOVE to receive:

- Books printed in the last 5 years:
 - Recent Bestsellers
 - Clean copies of "classic" titles
 - "Paperback" Romances, Mysteries, Urban Fiction, and Westerns in good condition
- Children's and Young Adult Books
- Gently used DVDs, CDs and Videogames with original cases
- Puzzles 1,000 pieces or more, no missing pieces in the original box

- Roseville area telephone books 1900-1960
- Roseville city directories 1900-1960

- Books that are 10 years old or more
- o Books in poor condition (yellowed pages, musty smelling, pet hair, broken bindings)
- School Textbooks
- Magazines
- Encyclopedias
- VHS or Cassette tapes
- Reader's Digest Condensed Books or Time-Life Sets
- Clothing Patterns
- Record Albums
- Product Manuals
- Journals or notebooks

- Materials MUST be brought in using clean non-returnable boxes and bags to the Circulation Desk.
- We can provide a Tax receipt, upon request, for the number of items, but cannot assess the value.
